In Memoriam Ann Jeanette (Fowler) Fox

DECEMBER 3, 1922 - JULY 23, 2018 (AGE 95)

Mrs. Ann Jeanette Fowler Fox, age 95, passed away Monday, July 23, 2018 at the Madison County Nursing Home in Canton, MS. An accomplished musician and passionate champion for music education, she was the only child of James Whitfield and Elizabeth (Bessie) Sherman Fincher Fowler of Holmes County Mississippi.

In April of 1948, she married James Hester Fox, Jr. and soon after moved to Canton, MS, where she remained for the rest of her life. While in Canton she taught music at Canton Elementary School and then later at Canton Academy. A life-long Methodist, she served as church organist for the First United Methodist Church, Canton for over 50 years. She also directed the church's hand bell choir and attended the Blanche Howell Circle.


She was an active member of the Canton Music Study Club and served as State President for the Mississippi Federation of Music Clubs from 1987 - 1989. Over the years she worked tirelessly in different capacities to support the Federation's music festivals and junior scholarship programs. She served as Junior Counselor for many years and most recently served as Extension Chairman. From 1980 to 1982, she served as President of the Canton Academy Band Auxiliary.

Ann Fox joined Canton Music Study Club after she married and moved to Canton in 1948. She served as club president 1949-50, 1951-52, and 1960-61. She was actively involved in the club until 2016.


